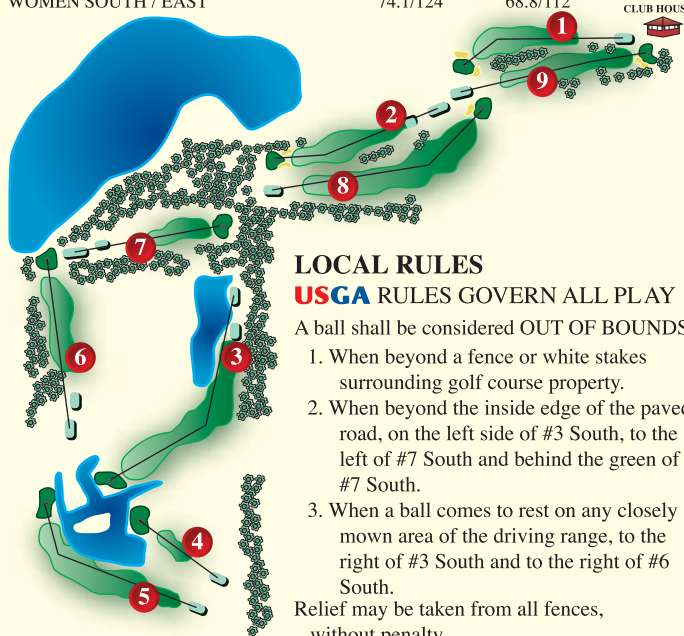
**LOCAL RULES**

**USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY**

A ball shall be considered OUT OF BOUNDS

1. When beyond a fence or white stakes surrounding golf course property.
2. When beyond the inside edge of the paved road, on the left side of #3 South, to the left of #7 South and behind the green of #7 South.
3. When a ball comes to rest on any closely mown area of the driving range, to the right of #3 South and to the right of #6 South.

Relief may be taken from all fences, without penalty.
